

Important Benefit Update

Infertility Services

If you are unable to get pregnant, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan covers services that may help.

Effective October 1, 2019, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will cover some drugs for infertility. This benefit will be limited to coverage for 3 cycles of treatment per lifetime.

UnitedHealthcare Community Plan will also cover services related to prescribing and monitoring the use of such drugs. The infertility benefit includes:

- Office visits
- X-ray of the uterus and fallopian tubes
- Pelvic ultrasound
- Blood testing

Eligibility

You may be eligible for infertility services if you meet the following criteria:

- You are 21 – 34 years old and are unable to get pregnant after 12 months of regular, unprotected sex.
- You are 35 – 44 years old and are unable to get pregnant after 6 months of regular, unprotected sex.
