Copayments are the charge or set dollar amount that members are required to pay for certain services per their benefit plans. Facility and hospital copayments are in addition to the calendar-year/policy-year deductible and coinsurance. Facility and hospital copayments do not apply to the deductible and continue to apply after the deductible is satisfied. These copayments may be referred to in plan documents as “per occurrence copayments.”
