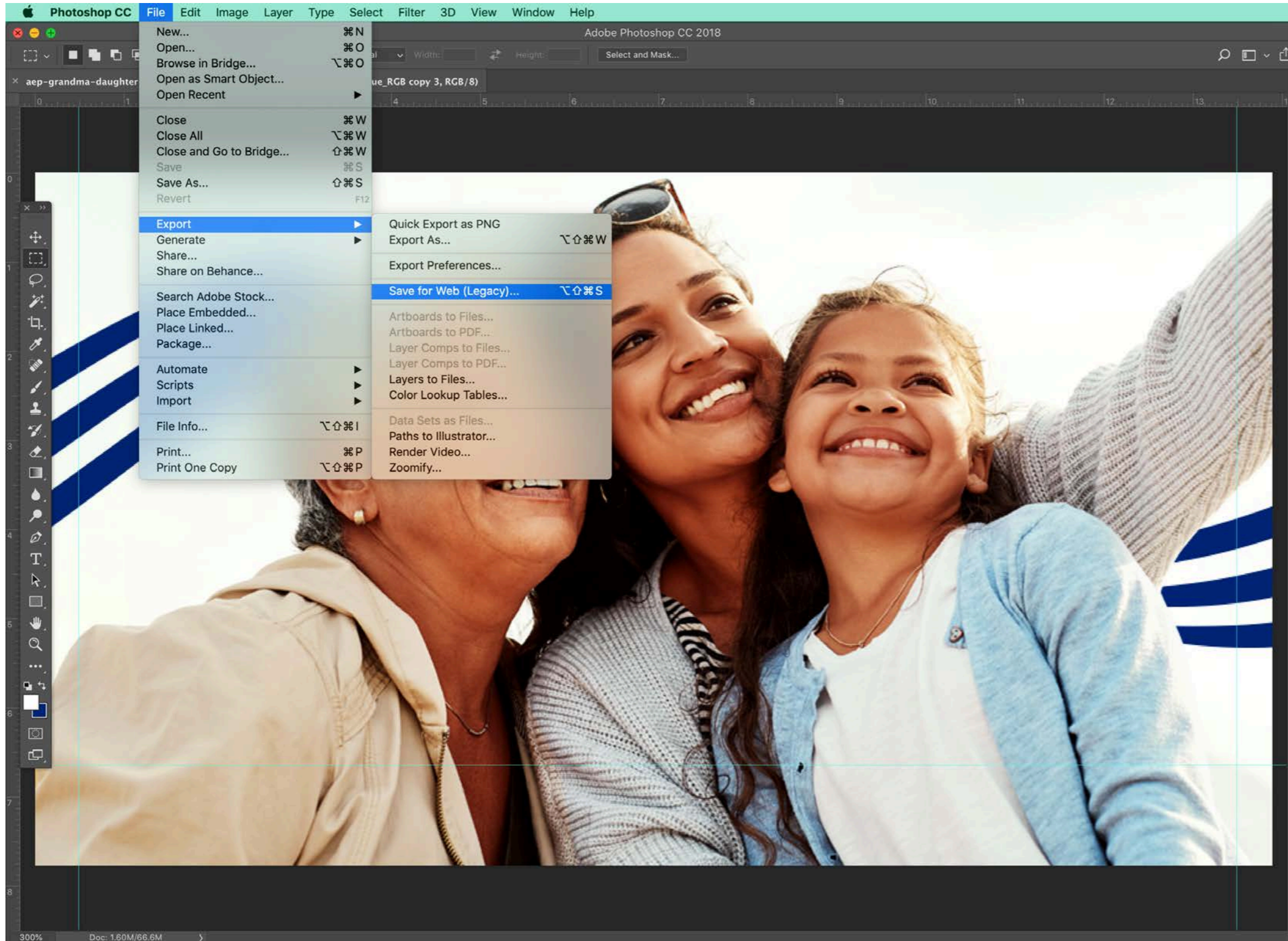


# How to save images for uhc.com

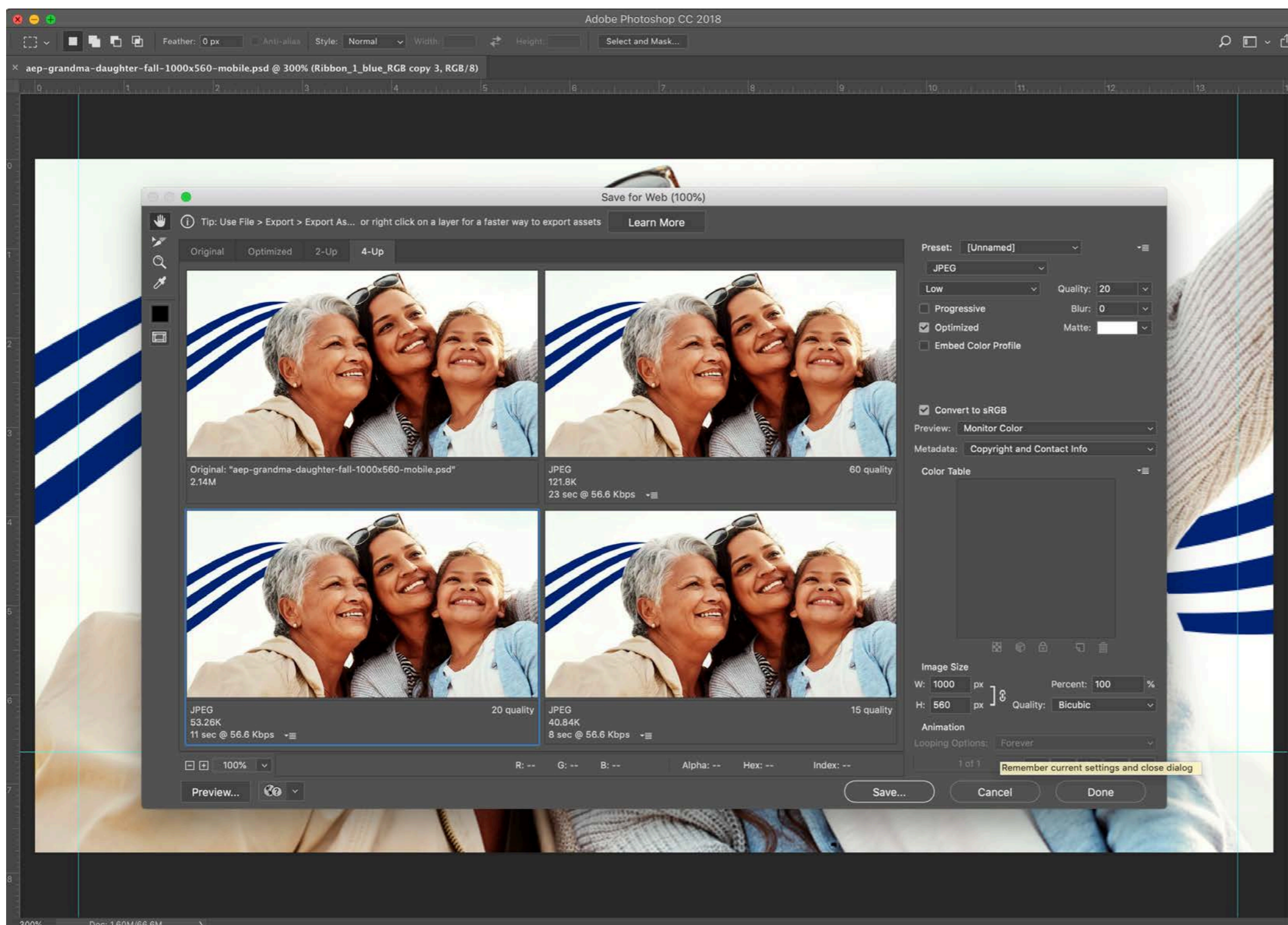
1. All images should be saved at 2x so they appear sharp on retina monitors.
2. All images should be saved as .jpg, .png, .gif or .svg
3. If you need an icon in your design, you do not need to supply those. They are pre-loaded into our AEM.
4. You need to supply a desktop image AND a mobile image for all images. For hero banners, we suggest supplying a tablet image as well.
5. All images should be optimized for web (in photoshop) so that our site continues to load quickly.

Here are the recommended steps.

Open 2x image in Photoshop. Go to **File > Export > Save for Web (Legacy)**



Select **JPEG**, Enter Quality: **20**. Hit **Save**.



## 6. IMPORTANT: Naming files:

Files should be names using **NO spaces and NO capital letters**. You should describe the image or the page it is used on separated by a "-" followed by the 2x size and then if it is a mobile image, tablet or "no need to label" for desktop.

Here is the equation:

aep-grandma-daughter-fall-1000x560-mobile.jpg

**descriptor-words-first**   **2x size**   **device**

So the other two device-type images for this particular image would be labeled like this:

aep-grandma-daughter-fall-1536x700-tablet.jpg

**descriptor-words-first**   **2x size**   **device**

aep-grandma-daughter-fall-3840x1086.jpg

**descriptor-words-first**   **2x size**
