Access Management

Member Portal

The Organization contains the brand name of the personal device the vital sign came from
- The USCDI version 1 Condition Resource using the US Core version 3.1.1 is provided with the provenance for each condition. The referenced Practitioner contains the billing Provider NPI
- Added the search parameters for the Patient Resource for name, birthdate, gender, and identifier
- Enhanced the Pharmacy EOB to reflect rejected claims
- Added the search parameter for the EOB Resource for last_updated and type (i.e., institutional, pharmacy, or professional)
