



Notice of separate premium payments for abortion

Your medical policy includes coverage for the termination of pregnancy (abortion). Federal law prevents the use of federal money to pay for elective abortion. This does not include situations of rape, incest or if a woman's life is in danger.

Federal funds may not be used to pay for an elective abortion. However, abortions are covered by your medical policy. When you receive a subsidy a portion of your premium is paid with federal funds.

Insurance companies are required to have a separate premium for abortion coverage, so that no federal money is used.

We use \$1.00 of your monthly premium and put this aside for coverage of an elective abortion.

This is required for everyone covered by a medical policy in your state, whether or not these services are ever used.

If your entire medical plan premium is paid with a federal subsidy, you will receive an invoice for \$1.00 per enrollee per month.
