

## Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Association Health Plan overview.

The Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Association has launched an association health plan to allow their small business members to purchase insurance like a larger business.

### How it works.

The Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Association health plan is administered by UnitedHealthcare and accesses UnitedHealthcare's Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) and Health Savings Account (HSA) nationwide network.

Offering 17 medical plans plus 6 dental, 6 vision, as well as life and UnitedHealthcare Global business travel insurance, this association health plan provides Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Association members with a large group status. This allows for rating flexibility, and helps small businesses not be limited to an adjusted community rating (ACR). Some employers have been negatively impacted by ACR and could benefit by moving their insurance to an association health plan.

### Requirements that businesses must meet to be eligible for coverage:

- Must be a member of a Chamber within the Southern Arizona Chamber of Commerce Association and reside in the county where the Chamber is located.\*
- Must have between 2–50 eligible employees.
- Must meet the participation requirement of covering 50% of the eligible employees — less valid waivers.
